PREPARING FOR THE TOUR

SAFETY:

1. Making SOP
2. (standard operating procedures)
2. Check the plan
3. Checking the equipment
4. Administrative aspects

TOURIST CONTENTS - PROGRAM:

1. Itinerary
2. Contributors - suppliers (transport, accommodation, food, additional content).
3. Program

TOURIST PROGRAM - ADMINISTRATIVE PREPARATION

Communication with the transporter

Communication - checking the accommodation

Communication - checking the food sites

Check the list of passengers, guide contracts, contract with a transporter

Verify safety statements and SOP guidelines for customers

A copy of the program (tour) for each client

TOURIST PROGRAM - TECHNICAL PREPARATION

Preparation of necessary equipment - personal and collective

Preparation of first aid equipment

Preparation of maps and navigation devices

Preparation of food during movement (cereals, dried fruits ...)

Preparation of spare equipment and options for its provision in case of lost baggage or defects

Checking the itinerary of the tour

Weather forecast information


Analysis of the movement - Activities
Development of a plan for alternative routes and alternative locations -
activities

Prepare the list of briefings

Contact with local rescue services

PREPARATION FOR RISK MANAGEMENT


Development of a safety management plan and risks analysis for the specific tour
