### THE BIG PINE TREE TRAIL

The trail starts from the pine trees close to the mountain hut Kopana Voda in 1540m height. The first stop through this trail is Bulec, a location that provides beautiful panoramic view. Further on, crossing again through a small wood of burned pine trees, the trail goes through Virovi, a perfect natural spot with small ponds and springs with drinking water. The next important stop in the trail is a natural limestone rock of Oshljak Mountain from where you reach the highest point of the trail at 2212 m. The last 10 km of the trail is downhill and ends at the Prevalla village or alternatively at the Village Gornje Selo.

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
